I am writing in support of the City of Martinsburg's application for federal funding through the Department of Transportations' Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) program for the Martinsburg Greenway Trail Network.

As the Ranking Member of the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee, I am proud to have spearheaded bipartisan legislation that will directly invest in our nation's infrastructure needs.
